Re-Enroll In 4-H:

4-H leaders/members who HAVE NOT re-enrolled in 4-H for the 2024-25 year will no longer get emails as of November 15. Please go to your family ZSuite account and re-enroll for the new 4-H year. Re-enrollment/enrollment closes for the new 4-H year on **JANUARY 1, 2025**.

4-H Interstate Exchange:

4-H members aged 12 and up are invited to join 4-H Exchange. This is a fun way to get to know fellow teen 4-H members from Carbon county and teens from other states. Carbon county 4-H members have travelled to Pennsylvania, Louisiana, Kentucky, Idaho, Utah, Delaware and Colorado on exchange trips. Cost to join is \$50 and includes a 2-year commitment. 
Family Fun Day Thank You:

What is the difference between the 4-H Teen Leader Program and the 4-H Ambassador Team?



We are restructuring, and the Ambassador team will become a part of the 4-H Teen Leader Program. New officer elections will take place in the 2024-2025 year.


