County commissioners are looking for answers

To the News:

One of the issues that arose from the Big Horn County Government Study Commission's work of the past year and a half is in the area of representation at the county level of government.

The existing form of government under which Big Horn County operates provides for optional community councils that would serve as advocates for specific areas within the county.

Voters from each of three commissioner districts would, in addition to their elected county commissioner, nominate three community council representatives from within the district who would be responsible for carrying local issues and concerns to the commission.

At the present time, Big Horn County has not implemented this option. The Government Study Commissioners and the Big Horn County Board of Commissioners would like to hear from the county residents regarding the establishment of community councils.

Do you think establishment of community councils is a good idea? Would you be willing to serve a two year term as a member of the three-person council representing your area of residence?
