

Yellowstone County Council Minutes September 7, 2023

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order at 6:40 pm.

Pledges: Presented by Rex Koivu and Lukas Arkell

Minutes: Minutes from June 1, 2023 meeting were read. Motion to accept minutes made by Skelly Adkins, seconded by Heather Arkell, motion passed.

Treasurer's report: Caroline Brito reported \$63,737.86 in account as of 8/31/2023. Exchange \$ is out of account, Stillwater and Carbon Counties have not yet paid for their share of 2023 Camp. Metra pays \$5000 towards Fair Chairman Expenses. Motion to accept Treasures report made by Karen Robertson Skelly Adkins seconded, motion passed.
